Literacy Activities

- Create your very own Mr. Men or Little. Miss! Using the character description sheet write all about them! Try to use a dictionary and use as many interesting adjectives as you can (even ones you may never have heard before!)
- Write your very own persuasive advert at home with reasons as to why people should buy your favourite toy! Use the sheet to guide you.
- Write a list of OPINIONS and ACTUAL FACTS about plants. E.g. opinion – Plants are the coolest thing ever. Fact. Plants are important for humans and animals to live. (Use the sheet and think of your own too!)
- Complete the comprehension sheets by reading and answering the questions using part of the question to answer.

Mathematics Activities

- Play the place value game. Challenge: play it timed!

- Look for 3 digit numbers in your house and garden. Partition them into hundreds tens and units e.g. $234 = 200 + 30 + 4$ (this is called the expanded form)
- Choose a 2 digit number and investigate 10 different ways to make that number.
- Collect information about the favourite food of people in your family. Present the information on bar chart using ICT. Print out the tally chart and table and stick it into your homework book. Include labels for the axis and titles for columns on your tally chart.

Creative Curriculum

- Grow your own plant at home! Keep a daily diary to show how it grows. Draw and write about this.
- Draw three different food chains which begin with plant life and end with animal life.
- Visit a local garden centre to take photographs of plants or research and find some of these on the internet. Make sure they are interesting!! Write information about these.
- Take photographs at home using a digital camera. Learn how to upload these to the computer using a USB lead INDEPENDENTLY – edit them on your computer and stick them in your learning log to share with the class.
- Research famous artists who use flowers in their art work. See if you can create your own masterpiece based on their picture using paints!
