### Literacy Activities

- Write a sentence about your favourite fairytale using the words 'like' and 'because'.
- Fairytales have a good and bad character. Is Jack good or bad? You decide and write a sentence explaining your answer.
- Make a list of as many fairytale characters as you can think of. Remember names start with a capital letter.
- Think of two rhyming words for each of these living things – dog \ cat \ snail \ bee.
- Create a booklet containing information about 5 different animals that can be found on an African Safari.
- Find out what the word 'endangered' means and make a list containing endangered African animals – use bullet points or numbers .
- Make a poster encouraging people to save an endangered animal.

### Mathematics Activities

- \*Design a money box with different Qatari Riyal notes in it. Colour the notes the correct colour.
- \*Use a number line to complete 10 adding sums. Remember to jump and count. (make up the sums)
- \*Use a number line to complete 10 taking away sums. (make up the sums).
- \*Draw 5 different size beanstalks. Measure the plants with a ruler and write you answer in cm.
- \*Using recycled 3D Objects found around the house – make your own 3D Safari animal

### Creative Curriculum

- \* Draw and label a suitcase containing different items you would need to take on a Safari Trip.
- \*Make a list of Safari animals and a list of Farmyard animals
- \*Make your own Safari patterns using a different animals– describe your pattern e.g. 2 lions, 1 elephant, 2 lions, 1 elephant...
- \*Using a map – recap the 7 continents of the world – find Africa on the map – locate Kenya and South Africa
- \* Think of similarities and differences between the UK, Qatar and Kenya.
