### LITERACY

- Pre-School** - We will continue to learn about Body percussions.  
**Reception** - We are reading Commotion in the Ocean and looking at ocean life.  
**Year 1:** We are learning how to write instructions.  
**Year 2:** We will be making changes to a poem and learning it by heart.  
**Year 3:** We will be writing our own versions of a fairytale  
**Year 4:** We are going to write our own fables  
**Year 5:** We are continuing with how to write instructions  
**Year 6:** We will continue to focus on the important factors of setting a scene in our descriptive writing

### MATHS
