Trips and Visits

Year 4 Topic Web Spring 2

Science

We will be learning about states of matter and how things turn or change into solids, liquids and gases. We will also be looking at the water cycle and learning about the meaning of each stage of the cycle.

Water

Water plays an important part in our daily lives. We will be learning about the journey of a river and how rivers play an effect on every day life as we know it.

P.E.

Pupils will be developing their techniques for shooting, passing and dribbling. Recap of the rules (especially for dribbling) and will experience more game play in preparation for the tournament.

Literacy

We will be focusing on adventure stories and scripts through a Novel Study of 'Billionaire Boy'. We will identify features and by the end of the unit, be able to write our own chapter for the book as well as change one of the chapters into a script.

Maths

We will be recapping the four operations, understanding position and direction. We will also be focusing geometry and statistics. They will then become more proficient in solving multi-step problems, covering various strands of the curriculum.

ART and DT

We will be looking at the famous paintings created by Monet, inspired by a river in London and we will be recreating these. We will also look at mechanical structures which aid rivers and we will try to create our own improved structure.

Music

Students will be learning how to read and write music notation, how to perform ostinato, and experience form through movement. Students will also look at how a composer creates mood though 'The Planets' by Gustav Holst.
