History

We will be looking at who Muhammad (pbuh) was and know that he was the founder of Islam. Know some key facts about Baghdad and give some reasons to explain how it became a major world power. Describe what the House of Wisdom is and know some key individuals who studied there.

Science

To recognise that diet has an impact on how their bodies function. To identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

Early Islamic Civilisation

We will learn in detail about the significance and importance of Baghdad in helping to build and shape this early civilisation and examine how and why it developed into such a major world power. The children will also have the opportunity to learn about other significant discoveries and inventions made by Muslim scholars in the early Islamic civilisation and to explore how items were made and where and how they were traded with the rest of the world.

Literacy

We will be focusing on narrative writing. The children will learn the importance of setting the scene when writing. They will also be creating their own characters, describing them in detail and bringing them to life. Atmosphere is also important in narrative writing therefore the children will be describing what the atmosphere might be like after a dramatic situation. As well as this we will be identifying the key features in a report and writing our own one.

Spanish

Spanish: Children will be learning time including minutes, daily routines, ordinal numbers to 20, prepositions and finally family members and how to introduce them.

Maths

Multiplicative reasoning – we will be looking at multiplying and dividing and the formal methods used. This will include large numbers, remainders, decimals, fractions and rounding. The children will also be looking at whether their answer is appropriate in relation to the question asked. We will also be learning common factors multiples and prime numbers and solving problems involving percentages (%).
Geometric reasoning – we will be focussing on 2D and 3D shapes and their properties, angles, nets, parts of a circle (radius, diameter and circumference) and angles on a straight line.

Arabic

Arabic: Al-Khalifa Al-Adel(Reading), Fael Al-Amar (Grammar), Al-Hamza Al-motatarefa Ala Waw (Spelling), Khat Al-Rok'ah. (Hand Writing), Fox and Rooster (Writing), Sahib Al-Naqab (listening), representation of the story (Speaking).

P.E.

All pupils will be participating in football. We will be looking at improving each individuals needs in dribbling, passing, control, shooting and general game play/rules and regulations. We will start to develop an understanding for some tactical play, for preparation for tournaments.

Music

Students will be continuing to explore the elements of music through theory and practise, Students will also prepare for the KS2 production.
