### Qatari History

We will be looking at the modern revival of Qatar.

## Topic Web

### History

We will be looking at who Muhammad (pbuh) was and know that he was the founder of Islam. Know some key facts about Baghdad and give some reasons to explain how it became a major world power. Describe what the House of Wisdom is and know some key individuals who studied there.

### Wildcats and Wolves Topic Web Spring 2

#### Science

To continue to focus on light. Explaining how light travels in straight lines, how we see things, how light travels and be able to explain why shadows aren't always the same shape as the object that cast them.

#### Early Islamic Civilisation

We will learn in detail about the significance and importance of Baghdad in helping to build and shape this early civilisation and examine how and why it developed into such a major world power.

The children will also have the opportunity to learn about other significant discoveries and inventions made by Muslim scholars in the early Islamic civilisation and to explore how items were made and where and how they were traded with the rest of the world.

#### P.E.

Cricket will be the main focus this half term building towards the QPPSSA tournament in March. Bowling, both under and overarm, batting and fielding will be covered.

#### Music

Students will be continuing to learn about music notation and learn how to write and perform their own melodies. Students will start a unit on genres of music.

### Literacy

We will be learning the different features of an explanation text (title, introduction, purpose, paragraphs, diagrams and conclusion). We will explore different types of explanation texts and creating our own explanation texts.

Grammar – focus on prefix and suffix meanings  
In particular – super, auto, inter, sub, mis, -ise and -ify

### Maths

We will be continuing to learn about negative numbers, mental calculations, ordering fractions, comparing fractions, equivalent fractions, decimals, percentages, ratio and proportion, co-ordinates, reflection and volume. As well as revisiting methods for the four operations and continuing to practise our times tables and mental skills.

### ART and DT

To look at different types of Islamic art and to create our own.
