### Design and Technology

Children will be learning about different species of birds that can be found in Africa.

They will be designing and making their very own bird feeder for the school playground. They will explore existing products.

### Qatari History

The children will continue to learn about the currency.

## Topic Web

### Geography

Children will be learning all about Africa! They will be locating different countries on a map of Africa. They will focus in particular on Kenya as part of their Safari Topic – exploring what a Safari Trip in Kenya is like! They will learn about the capital city of Kenya and will compare and contrast Kenya to the UK to understand geographical similarities and differences.

### Languages

#### Arabic:

#### Spanish:

Days of the week and months. Numbers 1-20, Feelings and emotions, Farm animals, Jobs and professions and parts of the house.

### History

Children will be learning about 'Fossil Hunters' such as Mary Anning. They will learn about her career as a fossil hunter and learn about prehistoric animals!

### Year 1 Topic Web Spring 2

#### Science

Children will continue to learn to identify and name a variety of animals. They will consolidate their knowledge of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will use and apply this knowledge when learning about different animals that can be found on an African Safari. They will learn about the 'Big Five' Animals of South Africa.

#### Going on Safari

During this topic children will be getting VERY creative!!!! They will be making animal masks, Safari sunset pictures and designing and making their very own bird feeders.

Children will be focusing on the continent of Africa. In particular they will be looking at Kenya and finding this on a map. They will learn the name of the capital city and find out information about the climate. Children will compare and contrast this to the UK which they learnt about in the previous term.

Children will be learning about different animals they may meet whilst on Safari. They will also look at the 'Big Five Animals' found in South Africa. In addition they will learn about fossil hunters from the past and what the job of a palaeontologist entails.

### Literacy

The children will be recapping everything they have learned in Year 1 through focusing on one book. Then they will learn about stories from another culture linking with this terms topic.

### Maths

Children will be learning to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. They will identify and sort multiples of these numbers. They will continue to consolidate addition and subtraction using a number line and counting on and back. They will solve one step word problems.

### Music

Children will be learning how to read and write rhythmic notation, how to play the recorder and how to identify the instruments of the orchestra. Children will also participate in a Production.

### P.E

We will be looking at athletics this half term. A development of jumping, throwing and running technique will be the focus.
