- Write a recount of what you do one evening at home or one weekend. Try to include as much detail as possible using time conjunctions and reason conjunctions.
- Read a book and write a summary of the book, which is no more than 100 words long!
- Learn a poem from your home country which you would be willing to perform to the class (it can be in your own language!)
