Literacy Activities

- Create your own Greek god and write adjectives for their personality and appearance.
- Choose a chapter from a Greek myth and turn it into a script (like a conversation).
- Design a glossary page for a fact book, write key words and what they mean. You should make this about Greece, Soldier, Sparta, Athens etc.
- Design a poster explaining when to use a question mark, an exclamation mark or a full stop to end a sentence.
- Pick a picture from the Vikings and write a description of the scene.
- Write a diary entry in the 'day in the life of a Viking'.
- Research a riddle that you like, learn it and be prepared to perform it to the rest of the class!
- Write an acrostic poem using the letters from the word 'VIKINGS'.

Mathematics Activities

- Make a Viking related poster, using at least 8 2D or 3D shapes.
- Make a 3D shape using straws.
- Research roman numerals and where they came from.
- Practise quick recall of all tables, up to 12x12.
