Weekly Learning Brief
17th - 21st September 2017

EYFS

Pre-School: We will be learning about families and asking where do we fit in?

Reception: We will be reading the story 'The Snail and the Whale' and practising our phase 2 phonics. We will be looking at 2D shapes.

ENGLISH

Year 1: We will be learning to read and write captions using our phonetic knowledge.

Year 2: We will begin our topic on Instructions. Children will learn to find time words, imperative verbs and connectives within instruction texts.

Year 3: We will be learning about the features of posters and creating our own.

Year 4: We will be learning about the features of a non-chronological report, linking to our Extreme Earth topic.

Year 5: We will be introducing the children to their first topic of explanation texts, looking at all the features.

Year 6: We will begin our first topic recounts, focusing on the features such as adverbials and the use of commas.

MATHS

Year 1: We will be learning to use a number line and count to 20 and beyond.

Year 2 : We will be learning about place value in two digit numbers, ordering numbers and using the vocabulary greater than, less than and equal to.

Year 3: We will be reading, writing, comparing and ordering numbers to 1000

Year 4: We are going to be looking at number and place value of four digit numbers as well as estimation.

Year 5: We will be looking at place value as well as adding and subtracting by 100, 1000 and 10,000

Year 6: We will be working on place value of numbers up to 10,000,000 and rounding whole numbers to the required degree of accuracy
